TASTING NOTES

Our rosé pours a pale cherry color. It has a fruity bouquet with clear notes of cherry, raspberry and red currant, and is fresh and playful on the nose. On the palate it offers a full-bodied structure, fine acidity, attractive freshness and a youthful winey character. A quaffable rosé with a red wine feel and persistent finish.

Best enjoyed slightly chilled with bruschetta, risotto and light fish dishes.

To enjoy this wine at its best, drink within 2 years.

IN THE VINEYARD

The grapes for the Lagrein Kretzer flourish at an altitude of 260 m on deep alluvial sandy soils in the Bolzano vineyards with their south exposition

IN THE CELLAR

About half the harvested grapes are pressed, while the juice of the other half is left on the mash for several hours and then drawn off. That is followed by temperature-controlled fermentation in stainless steel tanks at 19°C for 8 days.
